ELIGIBILITY: The applicant selected for this award shall be a high school teacher of a world language who has achieved outstanding success in getting his / her students to speak the target language through exemplary motivation and creative methods; the nominee shall be a current member of MIWLA; in addition, the winner shall be a teacher who has provided authentic immersion experiences outside the classroom for students to apply their speaking skills. No prior association or experience with ISE is required of the nominee.

ATTENDANCE AT THE MIWLA 2008 CONFERENCE—*The ISE Language Matters Award* will be presented at the 2008 MIWLA Conference Luncheon. The recipient must register for the 2008 Conference, pay MIWLA membership fees for the 2008-09 year, and attend the luncheon as the guest of the MIWLA to accept the award.

Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of the award.
